4. Old Business:

- a. Card fundraiser – due back Thurs. Nov.6, envelopes and items sent late so are not sending out. Will have an order table and cards at Student led conferences for parents
- b. Walk to Breakfast -tied into education week, paired up older to younger students, communicating and talking with the peers very positive. Suggestion to have a new scc tradition for walk to breakfast as opposed to the year-end bbq.
- c. Snack cupboard for Mr. L and possible lunchroom basket – Nadine spoke with the high school students about the bathrooms and any supplies they might need in there. Kleenex for in the washroom. Feminine products.
 - i. - snacks or food for kids who don't have- wondering about funds? Bottles of water, no current budget, does the SCC want to create a fund for this? Let's try it for a month and the SCC will authorize up to \$100.00 a month to fund a snack bin for Mr. L's office and emergency lunch items and a bathroom basket to be used by students on an as needed basis. - d. Feedback from teachers re: what the SCC could help them with
 - i. Teachers are Loving the view boards we have not heard back on our grant. If we don't get it the school would like to do 2 classrooms every

year. one through the school budget and one through scc budget. Will revisit in December.

- e. Student-led conferences-
 - i. 2 nights of conferences, with prizes for incentives. Booking through Kristina instead of the paid program. Bookings are low.

 - f. Nutrition grant update – grant accepted \$6,000, with additional funds to come later in the year. Gr.7-10 took a food handling safety course. Learning piece as students will be shopping, prepping and cooking a meal for the whole school. Roughly one a month. If additional funds will do a once-a-week snack item as well.
 - g. First school to be painted, will be first school in the fall.
